## How to get to The Greens at Cannondale

435 Danbury Road in Wilton, Connecticut  
(Danbury Road is also known as Route 7).

Use the Cannondale stop on the Metro North/Danbury Line

### Driving Directions:

**From the Merritt Parkway/Rt. 15 South:**  
Take Exit 41 / Route 33 North to Wilton. Follow Route 33 to Route 7 (Danbury Road). Follow Route 7 The Greens at Cannondale is past Wilton High School on your left.

**From the Merritt Parkway/Rt. 15 North:**  
Take Exit 39B/Route 7. Follow Route 7 past Wilton High School. The Greens at Cannondale is on the left.

**From I-95 South:**  
Take Exit 17/Route 33 towards Westport. Stay on Route 33 until you get to Route 7. (They will merge at this point). Follow Route 7 until you pass Wilton High School. The Greens at Cannondale will be on your left.

**From I-95 North:**  
Take Exit 15/Route 7 towards Norwalk/ Danbury. Follow Route 7, you will pass Wilton High School and The Greens at Cannondale is on your left.
